NUMBER OF COMPETITORS AND OFFICIALS

To be eligible for participation in the FIS Nordic Junior World Ski Championships and U23 WSC CC the skier:

- Must be a citizen of the country entering him/her (article 203.5 ICR),
- Have a valid FIS Code,
- o Fulfill any eligibility and qualification criteria laid down in the rules.

8 Cross-Country competitors Men 4 allowed to start per event.

8 Cross-Country competitors Women 4 allowed to start per event.

AGE LIMITS

The FIS competition year is 1st July – 30th June of the following year. In order to compete in international competitions a competitor must have reached their 16th birthday before the end of the calendar year (1st January – 31st December) in question.

FINAL ENTRY / ENTRY BY NAMES

All the participating NSAs must send their entries by names through the FIS online registration system. The system will be opened for entry by name as soon as the preliminary entry has been done.

Change of names will still be possible until the day before the first TCM (23:59 CET). After the deadline the system will be closed, and any changes of the names are only possible after the approval from the respective Jury.

FINAL ENTRY FOR THE COMPETITION

The final entry for each competition must be done in the FIS Online Entry system until 2 hrs before the respective TCM. No paper forms will be accepted. Should you have any questions contact FIS staff.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Announcements will be given in Finnish and English. The persons responsible of announcements are Mr. Aki Pajunoja and Mr. Aki Tuovinen.

SERVICE AREA

The Ski Service Area is located nearby at the biathlon stadium. The Service Area will be fenced. The fenced area is allowed to enter only by wearing accreditation. Each team has the right to park no more than one vehicle in the service area. Service Area will be locked during night time from 22:00 to 06:30. In case there will be a need to visit the service area during the locked hours, please contact maintenance+358503018816.

Keys to the service cabins are available in the Vuokatti Sport hotel reception.

STARTING BIBS AND TRANSPONDERS

The CC starting bibs and transponders (also the bibs for the sprint quarter finals) will be distributed at the stadium area 1/2 hour before the start. The athletes are responsible for fastening the transponders themselves.

SKI TESTING, TRAINING / WARM UP TRACKS

On the sprint days, the athletes can warm up inside the Vuokatti Sport Hall (court number 1, floorball court) 9.30-13.00. More information in each TCM.

START / FINISH AREA

The route to the start is following: from the Vuokatti Sports hall (swimming hall & Arena) parking place under the bridge to the pedestrian road. There will be signs to guide you to the start. The access to the centre of the stadium is allowed for the competitors and one service member per team.

TRACKS PREPARED AND OPEN FOR TRAINING

Will be informed in each TCM.

TEMPERATURE

Temperature measurements are collected at the stadium and along the course from the highest and lowest points of it.

The measurements are collected in half hour intervals. The first measurement is collected two hours before the first competitor starts and the last one is collected one hour after the start of the first competitor.

COVID 19

- Everyone must wear mask in the common areas, both indoors and and outdoor.
- Those who have been tested negative can go to the grocery store etc. BUT only 1-2 people at the time. Wearing masks mandatory!
- All the teams are expected to respect the Covid rules that have been made. If teams are not following these rules, LOC can give warnings, monetary fines or withdraw accreditation.
- Take your responsibility of reputation of our event.
- So far > 700 test take, 4 cases, all in control.

TESTING PROTOCOL DURING THE JWSC

- Antigen quick-test:
 - 1) Pre race control <48h the race, next on Mon 8th for U23 sprinters only
 - 2) for teams who are arriving on 7th of Feb or later.
- Positive Antigen test result will be checked with PCR in Kajaani, result in app. 12 h.
- LOC will inform teams if further Pre race controls is needed after Wed 10th
- Information from test result asap => email to each team
- Timeslots for testing on the previus days based on the names teams have sent us. Starttime for testing at 8.00 o'clock

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

- Official documents from each test as soon as those are prepared.
- In case of a positive PCR result, LOC /teams follow instructions of regional health authorities.

DEPARTURE TESTING:

- For teams who need an additional PCR or Antigen for departure.
- It's responsibility of each team to find out when and what kind of test result is needed. LOC will start asking teams about this on Monday 8th
- Prices the same 100 € / Antigen , 200 € / PCR. Latest possible PCR time at Vuokatti is Sat 13th -> result Sun 14th, lates Antigen ; no time limit.

OTHER SPORT FACILITIES

Due to the cold weather the ski tunnel is available for all of the teams when the weather is colder than -15 degrees Celsius. The main entrance is open between 10-15 and the personnel is letting you in; just tell them the code "Junior World Championships". Tunnel is open also on the other times but then you have to enter the ski tunnel from the back, that is connect from the ski trail. However, if you use the ski tunnel outside the time slot 10-15 you also must come out from the back and you are not allowed to enter the other common areas of the ski tunnel

building.







1 Area map





2 Stadium map – relay






4 Stadium map – sprint







6 Course map - Sprint women 1,1 km




7 Course map - Sprint men 1,4km


MEALS


Meals during JWSCH Competition week 8th to 14th Feb 2021

Lunch: 11.30 am. - 3.30 pm.


