Athletes and Team

The organizing committee encourages all athletes and leaders to read the Nordic Junior Competition rules. This is to get as much information as possible about the current regulations and how the competitions take place.

Rules for Nordic junior competition 2023

Each of the Nordic nation's (DEN-EST-FIN-ISL-LAT-LTU-NOR-SWE) may enter an unlimited number of participants. Additionally, the organizer may invite other nations. Each competition (XC women, XC men, relay women, relay men, NC sprint, NC individual, NC team, jump individual and jump team), will count as separate competition.

Athletes outside the nations teams can enter the races, in unlimited number. These athletes will not count in the nation's competition.

Participants outside the national teams cannot be named as individual Nordic Champion.

Entry

Preliminary entries, with the number of competitors and leaders, for each of the national teams must be made - <u>latest Wednesday 18th January 2023</u>. <u>Registration form for preliminary entries</u>.

Official entries with the **names**, **birthday**, **FIS-code** of **athletes** must be made - <u>latest Wednesday 8th</u>

<u>February 2023</u>. Link to registration form will be published on the competition website.

Entries are sent by official registration forms.

Athletes outside the national team entry with names, birthday and FIS-code

- latest Wednesday 8th February 2023.

Entry fee

Athletes representing national team (DEN-EST-FIN-ISL-LAT-LIT-NOR-SWE): 20 euro per athlete per race and 20 euro per member in each team competition and relay.

Athletes outside the above national teams:

25 euro per athlete per race and 25 euro per member in each team competition and relay.

Entry fees needs to be paid before arrival - <u>latest Friday 10th February 2023</u>.

Waxing

Information regarding waxing cabins will be available at https://hiihtoliitto.fi/en/nordic-juniorr/ later. One common waxing room at hotel nearby is reserved for teams (DEN-EST-FIN-ISL-LAT-LIT-NOR-SWE) for free. If any team need own waxing cabins for the team, there will be rental cabins at extra cost. Waxing cabins will be close to start and test area. Service Truck area will be available.

Accommodation

The organizing committee places athletes and leaders at Nordic Junior Competition in Scandic Laajavuori 200 m from Ski Stadium and 1,6 km from Ski Jumping hill.

Full board prices may vary depending on the room type and the number of people in each room, but it will be a maximum of 125 CHF per night per person as the rules say. An exception occurs when single room is needed. The need for accommodation should be send by using the registration form as soon as possible - latest 15th January 2023.

Transport

The organizing committee wants to see the need for transport and encourages participating nations (DEN-EST-FIN-ISL-LAT-LIT-NOR-SWE) to send their needs by registration form — latest 15th January. The organizing committee will then return to how the transport will take place. The price of transportation depends on the needs from the nations. All information about this can be found on https://hiihtoliitto.fi/en/nordic-junior/ after the nations have announced their needs.

Distance from the airport to Scandic Laajavuori is 19,3 km.





